Here's a glance at what the HOA worked on for the month of August:

- Completing the City Backflow inspections (ensures the safety of our drinking water)
- Painting completed for the K & A building garages
- Soffits (roof overhangs) were fixed for major areas of damage - additional soffit work needs to be scheduled.
- Approval to disburse insurance \$ from hail claim to owners who had window damage so they can replace their windows.
- Bids were received for tree trimming, which needs to be scheduled.
- Approval was given to reroute drainage for one unit in the J/H buildings area to evaluate if it will decrease the ice flow buildup we have annually on front stairways.
- Additional Gutters were repaired or replaced with larger downspouts.
- Heat tapes for building A will begin to be installed - this will (hopefully!!) prevent the ice buildup during the winter months.
