Thank you so much to those of you who joined the June 2023 HOA Board Meeting. The following items were addressed during our HOA meeting:

- The annual HOA Homeowners meeting is set for July 15th at 9:00 AM in the View room at the Garden of the Gods Golf Club.
- New legislation that affects the HOA in the state of Colorado was reviewed. It is required that we notify homeowners Pursuant to House Bill 23-1105, signed into law on May 24, 2023, an HOA Task Force is to be appointed by August 1, 2023, to examine issues regarding homeowners' rights and to perform other duties as noted in the new law. Each homeowner association in Colorado is required to notify owners about this task force. If you have questions about the task force, the HOA Information Office (part of the Division of Real Estate within the Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies) may have additional information.
- Additional legislation that passed
 - prohibits Policies that exclude the breed of a dog
 - Prohibits restriction of electric vehicles being charged in deeded assigned parking
 - Requires the HOA to give homeowners 3 xeriscaping options for landscaping upgrades.
- The repainting of the townhomes was bid out at. \$46,000. For the 5300's. And. \$124,000 for the 5200's. The HOA is still in the progress of getting additional paint bids.

Annual budget: \$289,100.00 April expenses: \$19,323.57
